Key Projects

Project Manager for the following projects:

- Master Plans – Water Supply and Wastewater (SA Water) – A series of projects with a total value of approximately \$5.8m covering all aspects of SA Water’s operations in water supply and wastewater. The projects address Master Planning of the Country and Metropolitan supply systems, developing hydraulic models of selected country and metropolitan sub-systems, preparing demand forecasts for Metropolitan Adelaide and developing regional areas, modelling the Metropolitan Headworks and Trunk Main System for capacity and water quality and planning future demand and growth in wastewater systems in metropolitan and regional areas.
- Country Water Quality Improvement Program Stage 3 (SA Water) – coordination of the land acquisition process for the sites of 5 new water treatment plants to be located along the River Murray from Renmark to Murray Bridge.
- Stansbury Water Supply Upgrade (SA Water) - A \$1.8m project to investigate and instigate a water supply upgrade for the Yorke Peninsula (SA) town of Stansbury. The project involved the construction of a 6.5ML, lined and covered storage and associated treatment and pipework. The project involved land subdivision and acquisition and consultation with all relevant authorities. Completed December 2006.
- Maitland Main Lay (SA Water) - A \$221k project to provide an alternative water supply from Maitland to a country lands supply. This project included the trial of the ‘plough-in’ technique for a DN125mm Polyethylene pipe, this first time such a large pipe of this material has been installed in SA by this method.
- Adelaide Rail Station and Rail Car Depot Groundwater Contamination (TransAdelaide) – An assessment of the nature and extent of groundwater contamination resulting from historical rail activities on these sites.
- Keep South Australia Beautiful (KESAB) - Graffiti Project (KESAB SA)
